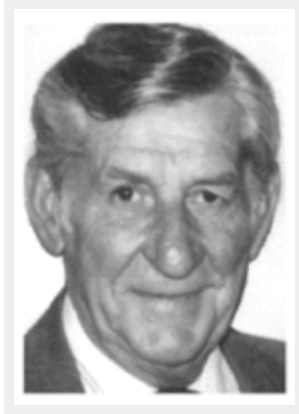

Clare Andrew Schmutz, 74, born July 18, 1930, passed away June 23, 2005. He was born and raised in St. George, Utah, and has resided in Las Vegas since 1960.
